We would like to bring you up to date with the work done by the Lamlash Improvements Association over the last year. We hope you will continue to give us your support in 2015 so we can continue our efforts to improve life here for residents and visitors alike.

Over the last year we:

- ✓ ran three public beach cleans in May, July and October;
- ✓ built and organized the bonfire and fireworks display in Lamlash in November;
- ✓ erected the Community Christmas tree on the Green and helped run Santa's Sparkle Christmas Fair (in association with the Glenisle Hotel);
- ✓ continued working on a solution for the shore front erosion;
- ✓ public toilet signs for visitors installed at various locations around the village;
- ✓ path flooding near public toilets improved.

The Glenisle Hotel, the Lamlash Bay Hotel, the Fire Brigade and the cleansing department at North Ayrshire Council along with many other local people and visitors have given us great assistance in running these activities and we thank everyone for their efforts.

In the coming year we plan among other things the following activities:

- ✓ beach cleans: 26.4., 26.7. and 15.11. (Sunday at 2pm) – feel free to come along;
- ✓ bonfire/fireworks (Sat. 7th November), Christmas tree and support for Santa's Sparkle;
- ✓ Lamlash Photo Trail and updating Lamlash village map;
- ✓ working with NAC to improve footpath to Cordon;
- ✓ continue working on a solution for the shore front erosion;
- ✓ creation of Lamlash website;
- ✓ checking possibilities for founding a film club in Lamlash.
